To apply for any of the scholarships, please:

- (1) Complete the BCF Scholarship Application Form; and
- (2) Provide any scholarship-specific addendums to the application form; and
- (3) Include a copy of your student aid report or a copy of your FAFSA application; then
- (4) Submit one copy, stapled, to the BHS Counselors' Office or six copies to Bartlesville Community Foundation (please no bound copies, plastic sleeves, folders, etc.)

Where applicable, "service to school" is defined as involvement in school activities, such as clubs, service organizations, school government, pep squad, etc.

Deadline for submission is March 12, 2010. A separate application form must be submitted for each scholarship for which you are applying.

Blair Thompson Russell Memorial Scholarship	\$1,000	Applicant must be a Bartlesville High School graduating senior. The applicant must have achieved a 2.5 grade average based on the four-point scale. Selection will be based on two important areas: demonstrated strong moral character and citizenship during high school years, and demonstrated ability to overcome personal obstacles in his/her life while demonstrating academic dedication.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. 500+ word essay explaining obstacles that have been overcome and areas of personal growth as a result of those challenges. 2. Two letters of recommendation, one from a BHS faculty member, one from a community member.
Lou Skurcenski Scholarship	\$1,000 (payable as \$500 per semester)	Applicant must be a Bartlesville High School graduating senior and a participant in high school athletics. Applicants will be judged on scholastic achievement, financial need, community involvement, sportsmanlike conduct and leadership, service to school, service to the community, and congeniality with students, staff and faculty. The applicant must have achieved a 3.0 grade average based on the four-point scale.	<p>150 – 200 word essay about one of the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. What it means to you to receive this scholarship. 2. A goal you will pursue in the future, and illustrate how you hope to have a positive influence on others by achieving that goal. 3. A recent obstacle you overcame and how you handled it. 4. A description of yourself and what sets you apart from others.
Green Country Cattlemen’s Assoc.	TBD	Both student and parent/guardian must be a member of the Green Country Cattlemen’s Association. The applicant must be a graduating senior who has been active in the beef industry or have a beef project.	One page essay capturing how the applicant would promote, support, and participate in the beef industry in the future. Personal interview and/or presentation may also be required.
